I didn't have a problem with drugs until a few years after I graduated high school. It began when I was prescribed painkillers for a back injury and before long I became addicted to them. That is when my life spiraled out of control.

When the pills became too expensive I started using heroin, because it was cheaper. But that "cheap" alternative to pills soon became a heroin addiction that cost me everything—my job, my car, and my family.

Once all my money ran out I started robbing houses in order to feed my addiction. Eventually I got arrested and wound up in jail. That is where I heard about U-Turn for Christ. I was not a Christian, but anything that would get me out of jail was worth a try. So after a few months in prison, I was released into the U-Turn for Christ program in New Jersey.

In U-Turn I met men who were faced with similar challenges as I was dealing with, but they were handling them very differently. They had a peace in their lives that I didn't understand, but it was something I knew that I wanted and needed. Since I accepted Christ into my life, things are getting better. I still have to deal with the messy consequences of my past, but I now have that "peace" and I am handling everything differently.

The Lord has blessed me more than I could have imagined. I graduated from Phase 1 and Phase 2, and have elected to stay on in the ministry. I have a job and have begun to pay back what I owe, and make restitution for my past actions. I have also been able to reconcile with my family and they are beginning to trust me again. I was recently able to buy a car and now I can visit my son whenever I am able. With the Lord's help I am hoping to become the hero that he already thinks I am.

One of the hardest things has been the loss of my marriage. I continue to ask the Lord to heal my wife from the hurt I caused her, and that one day she may be able to forgive me. I also have many legal challenges ahead, but I know, as I trust Jesus He will continue to give me that "peace that surpasses understanding."
