About The Program

U-Turn for Christ NJ is a Christian discipleship program dedicated to changing lives through the power of God's Word. Our primary goal is to help those who are addicted to alcohol and/or drugs be set free from bondage and restored to the Lord, their families, and society.

U-Turn is a 100% biblically based program emphasizing Christian growth through a daily routine of Bible study and service.

U-Turn is a two-tier residential program:

- Phase 1 is a two-month program where residents are supervised 24 hours a day and participate in a daily schedule of Bible study and service work.
- Phase 2 is a six-month program. Only those who have successfully completed Phase 1 are eligible. Residents live under the supervision of an overseer, and are required to comply with all ministry guidelines. They are expected to become gainfully employed and begin making a modest donation for room and board.

About The Vision

By the time a person becomes chemically addicted they are in a chronic physical and spiritual condition. At that point it is very difficult for them to stop using without intervention. Because of this addicts will oftentimes fail to change their behavior, even when faced with serious consequences.

Drug and alcohol abuse is widespread. Statistics show that:

- 7.9% of Americans are addicts.
- Every hour 11 people in the US die from a drug or alcohol overdose.
- In New Jersey, 39% of high school students have tried marijuana at least once; 43% admitted to drinking alcohol; 11.1% of adults used illicit drugs in the past 12 months.

U-Turn for Christ NJ is a ministry of restoration. We exist to offer God's loving hand of support to those in need.

About The Schedule

New arrivals will be accepted into Phase 1 and acclimated into the daily routine of Bible study and service work. They will be informed of all the house rules and asked to sign a contract agreeing to complete the two month restoration program.

The typical daily schedule consists of:

6:30	Devotions (Proverbs)
7:00	Breakfast
8:00	Morning chores
8:30	Morning work details
12:00	Lunch

Afternoon

1:00	Afternoon devotions
1:30	Afternoon work details

Evening

5:00	Dinner
7:00	Evening Bible Study
9:30	Quiet time/Bible reading
10:00	Lights out
