## James Aiello - Testimony



I grew up in a Catholic home and was taught to believe in Jesus Christ from a young age. As a child I thought that if I was good enough, and did the right thing, I would go to heaven—that was my ticket. It wasn't until I came to U-Turn for Christ NJ that my relationship with Christ began to grow and I learned what it means to have a personal relationship with Jesus.

I have a large family: father, mother, brother, two sisters, and lots of aunts, uncles, and cousins. My father and his brothers started a family business together "Aiello Brothers Cheese" and I always knew that one day I would be a part of that business. When I was a junior in high school I met the love of my life, Kristina Bieli. Kristina was my high school sweetheart, so when she died in a tragic car accident three years after we met, my life spun out of control. I completely gave up on the Lord—I could not believe in a God who would allow such a tragedy to happen.

## My life was shattered and I couldn't put the pieces back together, so I turned to drugs and alcohol to numb the pain.

It wasn't long before drugs took over my life and I began to push everyone who loved me away. I even turned my back on my family (although they never turned their backs on me). I struggled with the sin of addiction for six years. During that time I went in and out of a number of different rehabs, always wanting to change but never actually being able to do so.

When I came to U-Turn in March 2016, my plan was to stay for two months and complete first phase. After that I was going to go back to my father and beg him for my job in the family business. But as my relationship with the Lord grew I had a change of heart and decided to stay for another six months in second phase. I also decided to get a new job. These were both humbling decisions for me, but since I made them I have started to see real change happening in my life.

When I gave my heart to the Lord in U-Turn, His peace came over me. Since then I have been growing in my faith and getting deeper into His word. I realize that there's so much that I don't understand, but every day I thank God for opening my eyes and for giving me the assurance, through prayer, that my life is in His hands.

I thank Jesus every day for this house. It is here that I accepted the Lord's forgiveness and a man who was once dead came to life in Christ! The Lord has also brought healing to my heart and restoration to my family. I can't believe that after so many years of hurting them they still love me.
